Advanced Placement (AP) Exam Registration Directions

Registration for AP Exams for Spring 2019 has begun. CR students may choose to take an AP Exam(s) in a variety of subject areas. To be eligible for AP tests, students should be taking (or have taken) honors level (AP or IB) coursework in that subject area. It is recommended that students talk with their subject area teacher(s) for information about additional studies needed.

Registration Process:

- Students pick up the AP Exam Request forms in the Main office (also available on website)
- Students complete the request form and return to the Main office. All forms are due **Friday, February 15, 2019.**
- **This year Vancouver Public Schools is paying testing fees for all tests.***
- IB Students taking IB Tests this spring should look at the AP & IB testing schedules for possible conflicts. **Please note conflicts** on the AP Registration form so we can schedule a late AP testing session.

***Students registering for tests after March 9, or changing tests after March 9 may incur a \$55 late fee.**
