

- College and career-readiness for all students



IB Career-related Programme(CP)



What is IB CP?



 Students engage with a rigorous study programme that genuinely interests them, while gaining transferable and lifelong skills in applied knowledge, critical thinking, communication, and cross-cultural engagement.



Pathway to Employment



- The IB CP prepares students for the world of work, as well as developing a student's personal qualities.
- It leads students down a personally chosen pathway towards further/higher education, apprenticeships or work.

- 2 Courses from the IB's Diploma Programme (DP)
- The CP Core
- Career-related Studies





Diploma Programme (DP) Courses

- Every student in the IBCP studies a minimum of two DP courses.
- Students must test in their DP courses.
- Students may study more than two DP courses.



Career-related Studies



- Career-related Study is designed to prepare students for higher education, an internship or apprenticeship, or a position in a designated field of interest.
- Students learn about theories and concepts through application and practice while developing broad-based skills in authentic and meaningful contexts.



The CP Core



- Bridges the IB academic courses and the career-related study.
- Consists of four interrelated components:
 - Personal and Professional Skills
 - Service Learning
 - Reflective Project
 - Language Development
