Columbia River Forecasting

Hello, due to our school closure we are needing for some students to complete Forecasting for the 2020-2021 school year using a digital form. This includes the current 10th grade (class of 2022) and students who were not able to forecast before the school closure.

Forecasting is an important process which allows us to determine what classes each student plans to take next school year. The Columbia River master schedule is then built, and students are scheduled based on their choices. Please make your decisions wisely when considering classes, as every attempt will be made to place students into their requested classes. Since the master schedule is built, courses are offered, and teachers are hired based on Forecasting information, later requests to change schedules will not be permitted.

We recommend that students discuss their Forecasting choices with parents/guardians before completing the digital form.

Recommended Forecasting Process

- 1. Review list of present and past classes taken (Academic History is available on Family Access)
- 2. Review information and course descriptions in Curriculum Guide
- 3. Use the Forecasting sheet and Five-Year Planning Sheet to plan what classes (and alternates) a student wants to take.
- 4. Complete the Google Forecasting Form and submit
